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How to learn vocabulary and then make it stick!

The more words you know, the easier you will find it!

<u>Visual tips</u>

- Copy word lists over and over until the whole list can be written from memory.
- SACAWAC
- Take a "virtual tour" visualise yourself in your bedroom, assign words to objects, and visualise yourself looking at each object in turn.

Auditory tips

- Repeat word lists over and over until they can be chanted from memory.
- Record word lists onto mobile phone, mp3 file, etc., then play them on loop.
- Ask friends/siblings/parents/your dog to listen as you say the words out loud.

Kinaesthetic tips

- Devise actions for vocabulary in a word list, and repeat these actions over and over;
- Cut up word lists, jumble vocabulary up, then try to match it all together;
- Use realia to reinforce the touch and feel of concrete items of vocabulary.



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
