# Facts About My New School

School  
Task

You will have the chance to complete this with the HUB Team in your Taster session in July.

Questions about how the School works	Your answer
<b>What time does school start/finish?</b>	<i>School starts at 8.45am and finishes at 3.10pm on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday but 3.30pm on a Thursday.</i>
<b>What times are break times and lunch time?</b>	<i>Break is at 11.10am and lunch is at 1.30pm. On a Thursday it is 11.10am and 12.40pm.</i>
<b>What sort of food is sold? How much do things cost?</b>	<i>You can buy a hot meal for £2.35 (includes a dessert and water) or a snack like a panini/slice of pizza.</i>
<b>Where do students go at lunch time?</b>	<i>You can either sit in the refectory or outside in designated areas. Or you can go to a lunch time club or spaces like Bridges/HUB if you like a quieter space.</i>
<b>How much homework do you get?</b>	<i>You will typically get 1 piece of homework a week for each subject. Most homework should take between 30 minutes - 1 hour, but there may be some longer pieces if it is a project.</i>



<b>Questions about how the School works</b>	<b>Your answer</b>
<b>What happens if my homework isn't done?</b>	<p><i>If homework is not done then you will be given a C1. This means that you will receive one consequence point. If you did not complete a piece of homework for the second time for the same subject then you would get a C2.</i></p> <p><i>If you are having problems completing homework, then either speak to your teacher or someone in the HUB who will help. We will always be able to help.</i></p>
<b>Where can I do my homework in my free time?</b>	<p><i>There is a regular homework club or you can work in the HUB if you need some extra help.</i></p>
<b>What happens if I get into trouble? What are the sanctions?</b>	<p><i>You might get a consequence. A C2 (not doing homework for the second time or not focusing in class) might result in a lunch detention.</i></p>
<b>Who's the best person to talk to if I am having problems?</b>	<p><i>Tutor Teacher, Mrs Woods, Mrs Healey or anyone in the HUB.</i></p>
<b>How am I rewarded for my work?</b>	<p><i>House points/praise texts home. Reward assemblies. HP5 breakfasts with Mr Botwe.</i></p>

# Rewards and Sanctions

- Every Primary and Secondary School has its own behaviour management system.
- Your hard work in class will be rewarded but there are consequences for unacceptable behaviour.
- Tytherington School has a points system with house points (HPs) and behavior points (Cs).

## Do you know the Behaviour System at Tytherington School?

### Rewards:

- *HP1: You can get a HP1 for doing a good piece of work, representing the school or even helping out in the classroom.*
- *HP2: You can get a HP2 for good pieces of homework, answering questions in lessons or helping other students.*
- *HP3: You can get a HP3 for helping around the school or amazing pieces of work.*
- *HP4: You can get a HP4 for very good attendance or achieving above your target grade.*
- *HP5: HP5s are the highest reward you can get! They are given out by the Headteacher for 100% attendance or for an outstanding piece of work. If you get a HP5, you may be invited to a Headteacher's breakfast!*

### Sanctions:

- *Consequences range from a C1 to a C5.*
- *But we hope you will not be getting any of these!!*

Question	Your answer
<b>What time are breaks and lunch times?</b>	<i>Mon, Tue, Wed, Fri break: 11.05-11.30am, lunch: 1.30-2.10pm. Thur break: 11.10-11.40am, lunch 12.40-1.30pm.</i>
<b>How much homework do I get?</b>	<i>You will get homework from different teachers for different subjects. You should be doing 40-60 mins on a school night.</i>
<b>Can I stay after school to do my work?</b>	<i>Yes! There are homework clubs.</i>
<b>How do I complete my homework?</b>	<i>Homework is done online using Firefly.</i>
<b>What do I do if I do not have a computer?</b>	<i>There are computers in school that you can use.</i>
<b>Do we have assembly every day?</b>	<i>No, assemblies are not every day.</i>
<b>Who should I ask if I get lost?</b>	<i>You can ask any member of staff or another student.</i>
<b>Who is the best person to talk to if I get bullied?</b>	<i>Any member of staff that you feel comfortable with.</i>
<b>Is there anyone my parent can speak to if they are worried?</b>	<i>Parents can speak to the Pastoral Team, Head of Year or your teachers.</i>
