Key Stage 3 Assessment Windows

Dear Parent/Carers,

As you may be aware, your child will be sitting their first formal Key Stage Three Assessment in the coming weeks. Assessments will take place between the 8th and the 18th of January.

We have introduced these assessments to improve the clarity with which we assess your child's performance in a number of their subjects. Formalising the assessment process in this way also begins to prepare your child for some of the rigours of the formal examinations they will sit at the end of their time with us.

It is important that you and your child feel supported in the preparation for these assessments. To help you with this, an assessment booklet is available via the school website for each year group. This can be found at:


