A Patchwork of 'Smiles'

What is it that is making you happy right now?

At the moment these are often small things. Is it the blue sky, the warmth of the sun, your dog, the flowers in your or a neighbours garden? Maybe it is the birds, or a cake you have made, or maybe just a pattern, or possibly a loved one.

We want to make a patchwork of happiness and we would like all of you to have a go at creating a picture of whatever is helping to make you happy.

It needs to be 15cm square.

We would like to fix all the squares together to make one big piece which we will then exhibit in school. If you can, use scraps of material, cotton thread, wool, recycled clothing, buttons or anything that you have to hand at home – to make your square.

If you can't sew, then glue! If you haven't any fabric use paper. The choice is yours.

We want you to help us create a piece of patchwork that shows what makes you smile. The patchwork will reflect all of the things that made us glad during the coronavirus pandemic. The sky's the limit!
