A Patchwork of 'Smiles'

We want to set the pupils a challenge of making a patchwork of happiness, a picture of whatever is making them feel happy. We will eventually use all the squares to make one large artwork installation which we will exhibit in school.

Each patchwork needs to be 15cm square.

The pupils can use scraps of material, cotton thread, wool, recycled clothing, buttons, feathers, pens or anything that they have to hand to make their square. If they can't sew, then glue or staple! If they haven't any fabric, they can use paper or card.
